2007 McLAREN VALE SHIRAZ

The 2007 Star of Greece Shiraz has been carefully created from Shiraz sourced from four distinct vineyard sites in McLaren Vale. The majority of the fruit has been sourced from two vineyards which are close to the wreck of the ill-fated 'Star of Greece' which ran aground and broke in two in 1888, located just off the beach on the coastal edge of the McLaren Vale region.

The coastal sites have given the wine perfumed cherry fruit and peppery characters with firm tannin structure. The more centrally located vineyards sites have contributed cinnamon spice, liquorice and blackcurrant/blackberry fruit flavours with more power and concentration than the coastal fruit.

The Star of Greece demonstrates the decades of regional viticultural knowledge of the winemaking team in the harmonious blending of the different vineyard sites, giving the wine distinct structure and balance and a great combination of aromas and flavours.

This wine will improve for another 10 years or more; that is, if you can wait....
